

LCWSC FEES FOR FIRE LINE CONNECTIONS

August 23, 2005

I. Flow Test: \$250.00

Conduct a current flow test at the nearest hydrant or blow-off. At the request of the customer or his engineer, LCWSC will conduct a flow test at a specific site. Materials cost of all required system improvements, including taps, hydrants or blow-offs to conduct the flow test at the requested location must be paid in advance.

II. Engineering Review: \$250.00

Review and approve calculations, construction plans and specifications for all fire line connections. The Engineering Dept must approve all fire line connections.

III. Construction Inspection: \$500.00

Construction coordination, to include disruption of service, and construction inspection. At least a 72-hour notice must be given prior to construction and a licensed water contractor must perform all work not performed by LCWSC.

IV. Monthly Charges: (see below)

Any connection that has a fire line meter will be charged monthly using the corresponding meter readings. The rate will equal the LCWSC Residential Rate at that time, including the monthly minimum.

For any connection that has only a detector-check meter (considered non-metered), the monthly bill will be calculated as follows:
